

## Aurora Cooperative 2011 Scholarship

## Guidelines:

- 1. Applicant must attend a public or private post-secondary institution in the '11-'12 school year. The scholarship award will be sent directly to the financial aid office of the institution upon verification of attendance.
- 2. Applicant must be majoring in an agriculture related field with final approval of qualifying major from the Scholarship committee.
- 3. Applicant's parent/guardian must be an active patron of Aurora Cooperative.
- 4. Children of Aurora Cooperative employees or past recipients of the scholarship are not eligible.
- 5. Four scholarships will be awarded. First place in the amount of \$2,000 and other three in the amount of \$1,000.
- 6. Prior recipients not eligible.
- 7. Application must include 2 letters of recommendation. One from within school (administrator, teacher, etc.) and one of personal choice (not a family member). <u>Letters of recommendation must contain information about leadership, character, initiative, and school/community involvement.</u>
- 8. Scholarship decisions will be made by the Aurora Cooperative scholarship committee.
- 9. <u>Application deadline is April 15, 2011</u>. Completed application forms and letters of recommendation, along with a student transcript should be submitted in one packet to:
