Feeding Directions: Lick tub consumption will vary depending upon condition of the animals, quality and quantity of forages being fed, weather conditions, and the feeding location of the tubs. Cattle should consume 0.75 to 1.0 lbs. per head per day and fed at a rate of 1 tub per 25 head. Feed continuously along with plentiful amounts of high quality forage and an abundant supply of fresh water. Provide a separate source of vitamins, minerals and free choice salt during the first week of use. Place the tubs approximately 50-75 feet from loafing and/or watering areas. As livestock become acclimated to the presence of tubs repositioning may be necessary to achieve power consumption. Move tubs closer to increase, and further away to decrease consumption. Do NOT provide starved livestock free access to this tub. If over consumption occurs for more than two weeks, or for further directions consult your supplier or nutritionist.

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
