Feeding Directions: Lick tub consumption will vary depending upon the condition of the animals and quality of forages being fed, weather conditions, and the feeding location of the tubs. Use Right Start tubs for 14-28 days is weaning calves or in times of stress. Calves should consume approximately 0.5 lbs per head per day when fed at a rate of 1 tub per 25 head of calves. Provide abundant fresh water and place the tubs near water to encourage water intake. Provide a separate source of free choice salt. Feed in addition to a nutritionally balanced ration or plentiful high-quality pasture. For further directions consult your supplier or nutritionist.
